ABOUT US

The Pacific Link College (PLC) branch campus is located in the emirate Ras Al Khaimah, with the main campus in Canada. PLC RAK obtains a commercial license under the Ras Al Khaimah Economic Zone (RAKEZ); however, it is important to know that all academic programs and our educational permit is issued by the Ras Al Khaimah Department of Knowledge (RAK DOK)

The PLC RAK campus offers undergraduate, and degree programs in various fields such as Business, Hospitality, and IT. The programs are designed to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and experience they need to succeed in their chosen careers and the global job market. The PLC RAK campus also offers various academic and support services to ensure students receive a comprehensive education experience.

COURSE DETAILS

The current list of PLC RAK's approved courses is the following:

Digital Media Studies (DMS)

The Digital Media Studies (DMS) program provides an academic pathway for international and resident students, to gain competencies in the field of digital media. On completion of the program, students can progress onto further academic options or follow a career path in digital media.

The DMS program explores the interrelationship between digital media and information technology as well as new media design. Students will simultaneously upgrade their English competencies while exploring theoretical knowledge.

Information and Communication Technology in Business

The Information and Communication Technology in Business program is designed to address the business need for multi-skilled individuals acquiring the IT, business, and interpersonal skills needed for the current digital economy. The program has been structured to provide learners with a wide range of options encompassing IT, software and systems, infrastructure, and business.

Students will learn some of the essential elements of business: communication and presentation skills, accounting, and an overview of the functional areas of business. Foundations of technology are also integrated into the learning path to build skills in spreadsheets, programming, and website development.

Business Hospitality Management

The Business Hospitality Management program provides a pathway for students to acquire the knowledge, skills, and experience needed to work successfully in a wide range of hospitality business management careers. In collaboration with highly qualified and experienced industry professionals, the program is designed to provide students with the most updated and in-depth knowledge and skills in the hospitality world.

Graduates from the Hospitality program will be able to use standard hotel operation systems, demonstrate a deep understanding of hospitality management, practice efficient marketing and sales skills, deal with human resource issues, hospitality facilities, and front desk operations, and manage food and beverage operations and hospitality accounting procedures.

Global Restaurant Entrepreneurship

Our Global Restaurant Entrepreneurship Diploma program provides an academic pathway for international and resident students to acquire the knowledge, skills, and fundamental experience needed to work successfully in a range of restaurant management careers, as well as to run their own restaurants. It also gives students co-op placement to practice skills learned in the courses.

Business Leadership

The **Business Leadership** program enables students to acquire skills and knowledge in key business functions such as management, marketing, and finance. The program also helps enhance relevant knowledge and skills in economics, communication, problem-solving, and information and communication technology.

The Business Leadership program is designed to provide a broad understanding of business organizations and the environment in which they operate. It has a strong managerial focus which helps successful students' progress to management roles. In addition, the wide range of options enables candidates to progress to specialist roles such as human resource management, marketing, and financial services.

Tourism Hospitality and Service with Co-Op

The Tourism Hospitality and Service program provides students with an orientation to Canada, the education environment, English language and communication skills, and employment readiness. Each one of the programs focuses on different sectors of industry.

The Tourism, Hospitality, and Services (Co-operative Diploma) program provides all of the areas described above as well as a focus on the tourism, hotel, and service sectors of the UAE economy

Course requirements:

If English is not the student's first language, they must meet one of the following qualifications, or equivalent to demonstrate their English skills:

- High school graduates or mature student status (19 years or older at the start of the program)
- Language requirement (recommended for optimum success)
 - o Grade 12 English level; or
 - o IELTS 5.5 Academic; or equivalent; or College entrance test (63% minimum)
- International students must comply with the requirements of the Ras Al Khaimah Economic Zone (RAKEZ) and other RAK and UAE government entities regarding study visas

LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- Introduction to Google Classroom: Google Classroom is our primary platform for managing coursework, assignments, and communication. It serves as a digital hub where students can access course materials, submit assignments, and engage with their instructors and peers.
- 2. **Access and Setup**: All students will receive a unique Google Classroom code from their instructors to join their respective classes. Ensure that you have a Google account set up and are familiar with the basic functionalities of Google Classroom.
- 3. **Assignments and Submissions**: Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom with specific due dates. Students are required to submit their work through the platform. Ensure that submissions are completed before the deadline to avoid penalties.

- 4. **Communication and Announcements**: Instructors will use Google Classroom to post announcements, updates, and important information. Regularly check the platform to stay informed about any changes or new information related to your courses.
- 5. **Feedback and Grades**: Instructors will provide feedback and grades for assignments directly through Google Classroom. Students can view their progress and areas for improvement within the platform.
- 6. **Technical Support**: If you encounter any technical issues with Google Classroom, contact the IT support team or visit the IT Help Desk located in the main campus building.

OFFICIAL EMAIL

- 1. **Provision of Official Email**: All students will be provided with an official email ID upon enrollment at Pacific Link College RAK Campus. This email account will be accessible throughout the duration of your stay at the college.
- 2. **Primary Communication Tool**: Your official email is the principal tool the college will use to communicate with you. Important announcements, updates, and information about events and activities will be sent to this email address. It is essential to check your account regularly to stay informed and ensure you do not miss any critical information.

Student Visa:

The student visa will be under the sponsorship of the licensed college; or the sponsorship of his/her parent, who should be a resident of the UAE.

The student visa is valid for one year and renewed for the same duration upon proof of continuation of study. As part of the requirement, students must undergo medical and biometric testing. Once complete, students will be issued a 'Student Residence Visa', and an Emirates ID card will be supplied. The Emirates ID card is an identity card issued by the UAE and must always be carried with you.

Health insurance:

It is a requirement that all international students must have health insurance while studying in the UAE. PLC RAK campus provides 24-hour health coverage in outpatient, inpatient, and emergencies. In some cases, international students may wish for a premium health insurance package for which they would personally fund for their visa duration. As from the 1st of jan 2025, the heath insurance is mandatory for all the student.

Bank account:

Students can open a bank account if they decide of their choosing. PLC RAK has a personalized program to support international students with the complete application process. This can allow students to manage their money, teaching them to be more responsible with resources.

Student Accommodation:

The PLC RAK campus partners with modern and comfortable fully furnished accommodation options in RAK, offering easy-made residential living and providing students with affordable, and safe options.
